

2011 PLAYING CONDITIONS

1. A maximum of 24 company member teams can participate. Teams that have participated in the previous two years will be given preference. After that, the “first come first serve” rule will be applied.
2. Each company participating may be represented by a minimum of four (4) and maximum of six (6) players. All players should be a member of the CG&S Club. Each participating Company should have at least one player who is a company member of that particular Company, as recognized by the Club.
3. Each player must be at least 18 years of age and have an established golf handicap of the CG&S Club. Established handicap is a handicap without P(rovisional).
4. The form of play is “Emmastad **Four-Ball**”. The team whose player has the lowest NET score, wins the hole. The team with the most holes won, wins the match. Each player plays against the course which means that strokes are taken according to a player’s Playing Handicap.
5. **To establish a player’s Playing Handicap (see tabel in Appendix 1.)**

To determine the Playing Handicap at the start of each match, apply the following conditions:

- a. **For the first four (4) matches of the competition, everybody will play from 90% of their handicaps.**
- b. **From the fifth (5th) matchday of the competition* on, the player whose last 18-hole card was turned in more than 4 weeks before the Monday before the match will have to play for 75% of their handicap.**
- c. **From the ninth (9th) matchday of the competition* on, the player who has not turned in an 18-hole card since the start of the competition* will have to play for 60% of their handicap.**
- d. **The Playing Handicap of all Professional Golfers is 0.**

*** Start of the competition is: January 21, 2011**

Fifth (5th) matchday of the competition is: February 18, 2011

Ninth (9th) matchday of the competition is: March 18, 2011

4. Players can not switch teams during competition.
5. Each team will play every other team once. The match schedule will indicate the holes on which each respective match must start and will be emailed to all team captains and published on the bulletin board.
6. Matches will be played on Friday afternoons, shot gun start at 16.00 hrs.. As a result of special circumstances, the Match Committee may, however, schedule matches on other days.

7. When a match has been re-scheduled, the re-scheduled match
 - a. **should be re-scheduled for and completed by a date PRIOR TO/BEFORE the next officially scheduled matchweek.**
Please note that this rule only applies when both teams agree to re-schedule. If one of the teams does not agree, the match should be played as scheduled.
 - b. has to start from the tee box that was originally assigned [on the match schedule]. The match committee will, however, allow a re-scheduled match to start on a different tee box, if and only if both teams agree.
 - c. **Has to be played with the handicaps, number of cards since May 1, 2010 and the date the last card was turned that were valid on the date the match was originally scheduled.**
8. In order to avoid any confusions regarding the date, the starting time, etc. of a re-scheduled match, the match committee has to be notified by email of a re-scheduled match by both team captains involved and at least 48 hrs. before the start of the re-scheduled match.
9. Each match will be played over 10 holes: Holes 1 through 9 and hole 17.
10. Immediately after the match all results must be entered on the form on the bulletin board by one of the players: 2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie and 0 points for a loss.
11. The results of the matches of a particular date will be considered officially announced one (1) hour after the completion of the last match on that particular date.
12. A protest must be filed with the Match Committee before 20:00 hrs. on the same day that the match has been played in order to be taken into consideration. The committee will issue a decision not later than the next officially scheduled match. Protest that require interpretation of the rules of golf will be forwarded to the CG&SC Rules Committee.
13. The USGA and R&A Rules of Golf, combined with the CG&SC local rules will apply.
14. Standings of the competition will be published weekly on the bulletin board and will also be emailed to the team captains.
15. The Match Committee will decide upon all matters not covered by the foregoing.
16. Participation fee is **Naf. 750,00 per team** and will be charged to the team captain.

Appendix 1.

60%: If a player has NOT turned in an 18-hole cards after 8 weeks of the start of the competition.

75%: A player's last card was submitted more than 4 weeks before the Monday before the match.

90%: A player's last card was submitted 4 weeks or less before the Monday before the match.
